Rakshabandhan

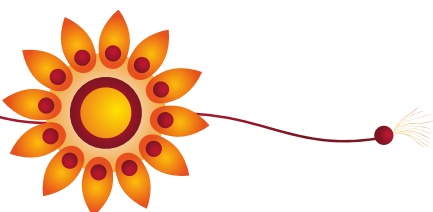

The senior boys built a pyramid and a small boy dressed as Krishna broke the hanging 'matki' (pot) and scattered the sweets which the children joyfully gathered up.



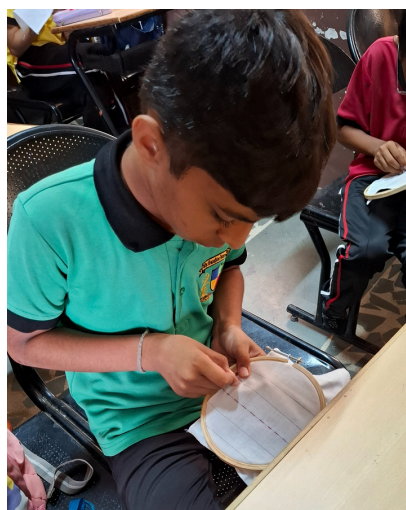

To, The Brave Soldiers of the Indian Armed Forces.

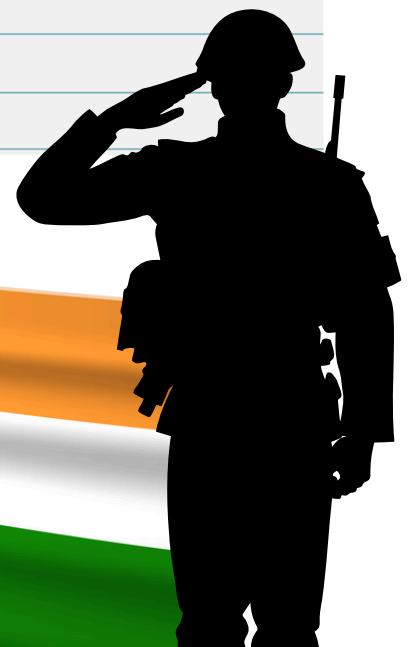
